ATTENDED FUNERAL (funeral director charges only)	£2525.00
This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased	
person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation	
- Taking care of all legal and administrative arrangements	£1350.00
- Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally	£240.00
